No Boundaries

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, LORI PARKER

On opposite sides of the building, two women are facing the consequences of their sexual choices. One woman breaks down when she hears that her pregnancy test is positive while another woman tries to come to terms with having a sexually transmitted disease (STI/STD) that can be treated but not cured. The outcomes may be different but at the core of their crisis is their sexual choices.

With few exceptions, not having boundaries around when and with whom men and women have sex has resulted in over 1 million aborted babies every year in this country alone. Sexual messages are everywhere. Its allure can be used to sell cars or even candy. It is influencing children at a very young age who are now trying to live out what they see on movies and hear in the lyrics of popular songs.

Sex has become so common place that even many Christians parents opt for birth control education over abstinence education because they believe abstinence is no longer a realistic alternative. Meanwhile, STI/STDs are on the rise, children are addicted to pornography, and fewer people (both Christian and non-Christian) see the necessity for setting boundaries through marriage. To see measurable change in the number of unplanned pregnancies and new STI/STD cases we must go to the heart of the problem, which is sexual immorality.

Planned Parenthood usually begins relationships with women through non-pregnancy related medical services like STD testing. Because pregnant women tend to

go to the medical clinic they have been to before, FCWC will continue to increase medical services for non-pregnant women to build close relationships that will bring them back here.

In 2014, First Care Women's Clinic added STI/STD testing to the free medical services

we offer. It was clear that the women who face unplanned pregnancies are often the women who are at risk for contracting a sexual disease or infection. Being able

to help these women (and men) make healthy sexual choices is a pro-active way to prevent unplanned pregnancies that could result in abortions in the future.

The abortion battle begins before a child is conceived. The moment a woman chooses to have sex without preparing for the consequences of her decision, she places her children at risk. We at FCWC will start here as we influence the lives of men and women through education and the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Testing for sexually transmitted diseases is the costliest service we have ever provided. Because we are located in the county with the fourth highest abortion rate, it's important that we reach these women as soon as possible, and begin our medical/client relationship. We hope to begin advertising via several media platforms soon and need your help. 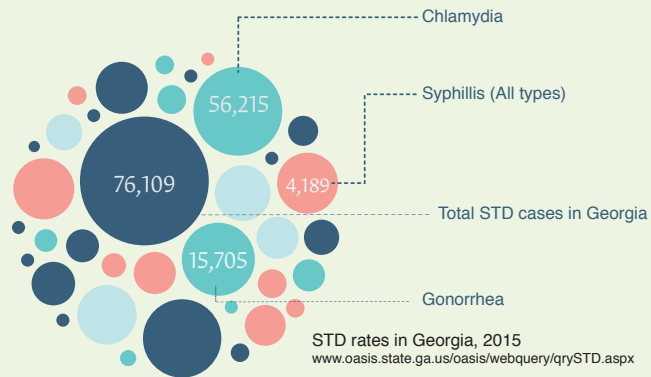
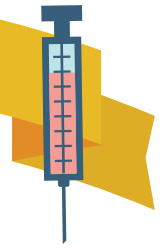

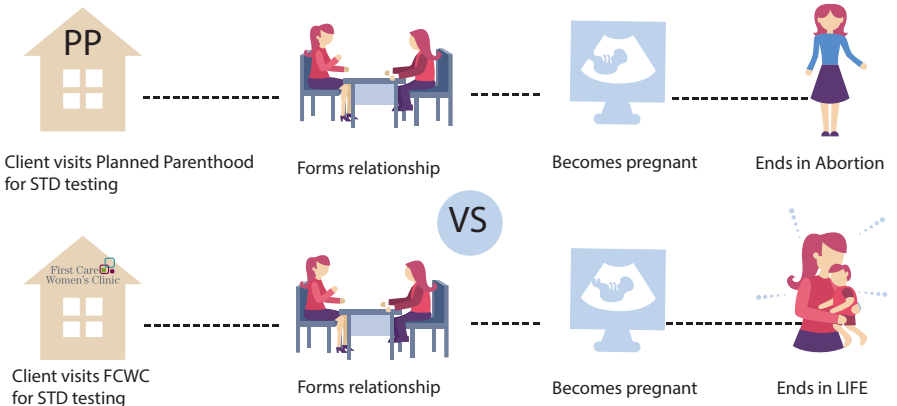
